

Attendance

The Pennsylvania Department of Education collects attendance data through an electronic reporting system called the Pennsylvania Information Management System (PIMS). It is important that we report attendance accurately. The following conditions constitute reasonable cause for absence from school:

- Student illness
- Danger to health from serious exposure
- Quarantine
- Recovery from accident
- Required court attendance
- Death in family
- Doctor or dentist appointment when necessary during school hours

Our reporting system will automatically default all absences to unexcused unless a written note is received within three days of your child's absence. If three (3) absences remain unexcused you may receive an automatically generated letter identifying your child as truant. Please be sure to return a written excuse note to your child's homeroom teacher within three days of their return to school.
