HHS PRESENTS FAFSA COMPLETION NIGHT

The Haverford High School Counseling Department is sponsoring a FAFSA Completion Night on Monday, November 20, 2017 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. This event will take place at Haverford High School in Room 250, and will be conducted by a representative from PHEAA (PA Higher Education Assistance Agency). The evening will be organized into one-hour time slots to ensure each family has a computer. In order to attend this event, please sign-up for a one-hour time slot on Sign-Up Genius.

On November 20th, please bring all documents needed to complete the FAFSA Application, including:

Social Security Numbers (Parent and Student)

2016 Federal Income Tax Returns

W-2 Forms

Current bank statements and other income and asset documentation.

You will also need a FSA ID for the student and parent, as well as two different email addresses, in order to electronically complete and sign the FAFSA. Apply for a FSA ID at www.fafsa.gov. 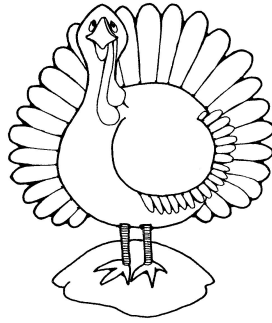

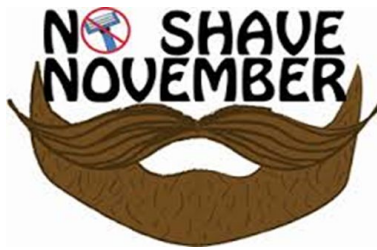

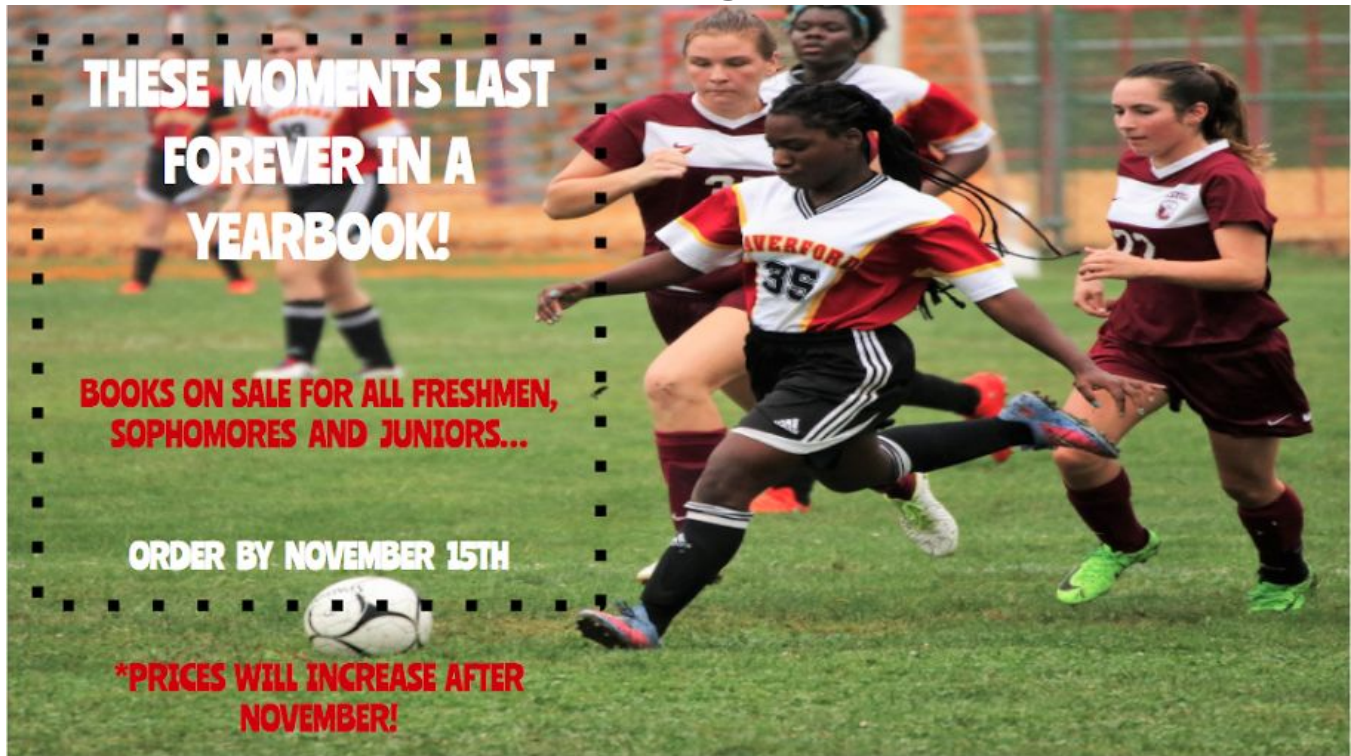
