

Summer Reading and Math

Digital and non-digital activities including summer reading and math practice available at your child's level.

Self-paced and designed to include games and activities that keep students engaged.

Continued access to all activities and resources that were available throughout Flexible Learning

Virtual Summer School



1-5 - 3 Weeks; 2 hours/day/subject

Virtual programming with synchronous instruction as well as independent work
Students virtually meet with the teacher daily

Recommended by Teacher at Conference Time

6-8 - Varying times; STEM and Humanities Activity-Based Learning

Virtual activities, projects, and competitions to reinforce and maintain skills from this school year; hosted live by teachers; sign up required

Virtual Summer School



9-12 - 6 weeks; 2 hours/day/subject

Credit Recovery or Original Credit; synchronous and asynchronous instruction and activities

Extended School Year- 5 Weeks; Schedule varies based on program

Virtual programming with synchronous and/or asynchronous instruction/check-ins as well as independent work






Educational Delivery Mode Continuum
