

COVID-19 Transportation Policies & Procedures:

The School District of Haverford Township is taking every precaution for the health and safety of our students and has implemented a series of safety and PPE protocols in our daily transportation operations. In this regard, we have implemented the following protocols in accordance with guidance from the CDC, PA Department of Health, and Chester County Health Department: (Link to the Health and Safety Plan)

- Parents / guardians are required to take the temperature of every child daily and confirm the child is symptom-free before boarding the school bus.
- Students are expected to maintain social distancing at the bus stops.
- School buses will be disinfected after each morning and afternoon shift.
- After each school drop-off, high touch areas on the school bus will be sanitized.
- All school bus drivers / aides will be wearing a face mask at all times while students are being transported.
- Students are required to wear a face covering while on the school bus. Disposable face masks will be available on the school bus, as needed. (If a student refuses to wear a face mask, they will be placed in the forward section on the passenger side of the school bus.)
- Students will load the school bus back to front. Siblings should sit together.

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us and we appreciate your assistance in our COVID-19 safety procedures and in making this a successful school year for all students.
