## Cradles to Crayons

**Who We Are**  
Cradles to Crayons® leads the way in filling an unrecognized yet critical gap in services for families in low-income and poverty situations. We recognize that basic needs such as weather-appropriate clothing, shoes, and books are as important as food and shelter. By providing these items, Cradles to Crayons enables children to participate more fully in school and life activities while also relieving their parents' stress.

**Our Mission**  
We work to provide children from birth through age 12, living in homeless or low-income situations, with the essential items they need to thrive—at home, at school, and at play. We supply these items free of charge by engaging and connecting communities that have with communities that need.

**The Need**  
-Among major U.S. cities, Philadelphia has the highest rate of deep poverty in the nation.  
-46% of children (over 300,000) in The Greater Philadelphia Region live in poverty or in a low-income household.  
-Poverty is growing twice as fast in the suburbs than it is in the city.

For ten years, Cradles to Crayons has earned Charity Navigator's highest rating of four stars, certifying our 501(c)(3) organization's commitment to accountability, transparency, and responsible fiscal management.







**Everyday Essentials**  
When children lack essential items, they cannot engage outside the home and miss out on having the same opportunities as their peers. We believe that the items we provide—clothing for a week, shoes, pajamas, socks, underwear, personal items, and more—are essential to a child's physical, social, and emotional well-being, fostering their ability to attend school and thrive academically. Our KidPacks are also bundles of relief for parents who cannot afford basic necessities for their children.


**Our Model**  
We have designed an efficient model of collecting new and like-new children's items via community drives, drop-boxes, bulk purchases, and corporate donations. The donated items are processed and packaged into KidPacks by 24,000 dedicated volunteers at our Giving Factory®, and are distributed free of charge to disadvantaged children through a collaborative, network of social service agencies and school partners.

**Our Success**  
In the past ten years of operation - Cradles to Crayons Philadelphia has served over 450,000 children in the Greater Philadelphia region.
