College Affordability & Paying for College: 9/23/19 at 7:00 PM in room 126. Speaker: Fred Amrein is a nationally, recognized expert in college funding and the student loan repayment will be the speaker on financial aid topics.

This presentation helps parents understand how the financial aid process works and gives insights into how to pay for college. The major topics that will be addressed in this program will be a review of the Financial Aid process, explanation of Expected Family Contribution, Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and student loan structure. In addition, other topics highlighted are the cost of college, the importance of four-year cost projections and strategies to lower the cost of college.

This event is for senior families with students entering post-secondary institutions in Fall 2020. PSAT: The PSAT will be given on October 16, 2019. The PSAT is practice for the SAT and is open to 9th, 10th and 11th-grade students. Is also qualifies 11th-grade students for National Merit Scholarships. The PSAT assesses the same knowledge and skills as the SAT, providing a checkin on college readiness before taking the SAT. Please register and submit payment on the school district website.

Naviance: Continue to utilize Naviance (<u>https://connection.naviance.com/haverfordshs</u>), a comprehensive post-high school planning tool, to explore possible post-high school options. Naviance can help you to identify your interests, research careers and colleges, and maintain a list of prospective colleges. You will also use Naviance to complete assessments and perform tasks in preparation for career readiness.

How to log in to Naviance:

Email (ID): first letter of your first name, last name, homeroom (example: jdoe2021w). No spaces. Password: first letter of your first name, the first letter of your last name, five-digit PowerSchool ID (example: jd12345). No spaces.

Create a personal email address that can be used for post-high school planning. Your school district email should not be used.

What Is Dual Enrollment?

The College's Dual Enrollment Program provides eligible high school students the opportunity to earn college

credits while they're still in high school at a fraction of the standard tuition rates. Interested high school

students are invited to apply and participants are selected based on demonstrated academic ability and motivation. Accepted high school students can take a maximum of 21 credits at the Dual Enrollment discounted price.


