NBHS Welcomes Temple and Drexel University's School of Business Admissions Representatives

The National Business Honor Society's first two membership meetings included visits from Temple and Drexel University's Schools of Business. The members were pleased and honored to welcome Laura Broomell, The Assistant Director of Enrollment for Temple's Fox School of Business, Kennedy Price, a Senior at Fox & VP of Temple's FBLA, and Heather Lations, Drexel's LeBow's Assistant Director of Undergraduate Business Programs and Recruitment.

During the presentations, all of the speakers discussed the many aspects of what their Schools of Business are looking for in their applicants and all of the opportunities that the school offers. This included explaining a variety of business majors, on campus clubs, internship/co-op programs, and the study abroad opportunities to enhance our education as part recognizing that we are living in a global economy.

The are many different majors available within these Schools of Business that are outside of the traditional majors we tend to think of such as Marketing and Accounting. Some of the most interesting majors included: Applied Finance, Business and Engineering, Business Analytics, Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management, Supply Chain Management, and International Business.

So many of us NBHS members are interested in the stock market and investments. We very impressed with what we learned from Ms. Lations about "The Dragon Fund", which is LeBow's student-managed equity portfolio. It was started in the fall of 2007 with

\$250,000 and has since grown to more than \$1.8 million. The fund is managed by LeBow undergraduates through two courses, Applied and Advanced Portfolio Management. Hearing about programs such as this, which is built into the college curriculum, was very exciting.

To kick off the school year, we were given excellent and eye-opening insight into what the Admissions Offices are looking for in college applications as well as the many opportunities that are upon us as we prepare to enter college.
