Amy's Kisses Foundation Memorial Scholarship:

As a Havertown native, Amy graduated at the top of the HHS Class of 1983 and went on to earn degrees from Cornell University and The Wharton School of Business before co-founding a successful college test preparation organization shortly before her untimely death and that of her children in October, 2011.

She was known to praise her students by tossing them chocolate candy from the bowl she kept on her desk. Additionally, Amy frequently spoke of wanting to establish a formal, need-based scholarship program for her services before her life was cut short.

Amy's Kisses Foundation, a nonprofit, 501 (c) (3) co-founded by Amy's only sibling, Jill Gobora (HHS Class of 1984) and her lifelong best friend, Patti Cush (HHS Class of 1983), now celebrates her generosity of spirit, her commitment to academic excellence, and her enduring legacy by providing Kisses of Opportunity in the form of domestic violence education and resources, as well as educational scholarships and support to deserving students, throughout the U.S.

Applicant requirements:

- Applicant must be a Haverford High School college bound senior who can demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- Applicant must complete a response to the following essay question supplied by the Amy's Kisses Scholarship Committee (no more than 500 words).

Scholarship Essay: In 500 words or less, please describe a conflict that you have witnessed or been personally involved in, and how you tried to resolve it.
