Original Credit Courses All original credit math courses are honors level, blended courses* Algebra I*, Geometry, Algebra II, & Pre-Calculus \$425 residents - \$425 non-residents (* offered only to Haverford Township students) Work Study (1 credit maximum = 200 hours worked) 11th & 12th Grade ONLY - with Guidance Counselor Approval \$225 resident; \$325 non-resident II. Repeat Credit Courses All repeat courses are level-3* \$225 residents - \$325 non-residents unless otherwise stated Algebra I, II & Geometry English 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th Social Studies 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th *Summer School Mathematics is an online course which utilizes the ALEKS educational program (available 24/7). On their own time, students must meet or exceed the minimum number of hours online and topics mastered in order to pass the course. With the exception of one (1) doctor excused absence for repeat credit students. Original credit courses will be conducted entirely online. Repeat credit courses will require at least one (1) day of in-school work per week.	Registration Registration will begin on Monday, June 3rd and end on Friday, June 21st. Keystone Testing	Special Notes
Students who were not successful on Keystone exams in Algebra I or Literature can choose to take the corresponding summer school class and retake the Keystone exam in August. Students opting to take the Keystone exam in the summer must register for the exam by Friday, June 21st.	Dr. Steve Quinn is the Principal of Summer Session operations at HHS. He can be reached on 610.853.5900 ext. 2551. Final course offerings will depend upon a sufficient number of applications. All enrollments will be limited and applications will be accepted in the order received. To receive course credit, the student MUST attend the complete summer session. Attendance in Summer School is critical. If a student is dropped from a course due to lack of attendance, no refund will be granted. All registrations must be made in person - not by mail or phone. Once a class has begun there will be no refunds. Some courses/grades may be combined to meet enrollment requirements. Room location will be posted on the first day of Summer School. Original credit Summer Session math is an Honors level course. It is a high level, fast paced course designed for top level math students. Please be mindful of this before signing up for these courses.

If you have been experiencing issues with the app, please follow the below steps.

The steps to perform this refresh are:

1. Open the SchoolMessenger app.
2. Go to the menu in the upper left corner.
3. Choose contacts.
4. Once in contacts, press the refresh button in the upper right-hand corner.
5. This screen will still show an error, but when you open the menu from the upper left the second time, you will have access to Attendance. Messages will also be populated with all recent messages you were sent.
6. At this point, your app should be functioning normally again.
