Applicant requirements:

- Awarded to a graduating senior who has been actively involved at Haverford High School or within the Haverford Township community
- Recipient will be hard-working, determined, and well-rounded
- Weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Recipient must be accepted into an institution for higher learning, not restricted to a four-year institution
- Those with financial need will be given extra consideration
- Applicant must complete a response to the following essay question supplied by the Family of Maurice E. Cox, Jr. (no more than 250 words).

Scholarship Essay: In 250 words or less, please describe a specific Book, Movie, Play, Song, Poem, or any work of Art that has influenced you and why. Please indicate in a brief statement at the bottom of the essay if financial need should be considered.

- Include a title page with the following information:
Scholarship name, Applicant name, Home address, Phone number, Email address, Name of School/University applicant is planning to attend, Intended college major:
- Include first and last name on each page of the essay.
