
To prepare for the Best Buddies job, Sophie attended the Leadership

The Fund was formed in 2004 as a worthy tribute to Steve Juenger who passed away in November 2003 at the age of 88. Coach Juenger was actively involved at Haverford High School for over 55 years, coaching basketball and other sports for 45 years. After "retiring," he continued to help at Haverford. He had a profound influence on thousands of students—in the classroom, in the gym, and on athletic fields.

Since our kickoff meeting 14 years ago, over 320 alumni and friends have stepped forward to contribute to the Stephen M. Juenger Memorial Fund with gifts ranging from \$10 to \$5,000.

## Juenger Fund Update

Over the past 14 years, we have distributed scholarships totaling \$115,250. In 2005, we awarded \$750 per student. Last year, this was up to \$8,000 per student. This year, it's up to \$9,000.

Our focus is on two scholarships. One goes to a Haverford senior athlete who best displays the attributes taught by Steve Juenger—leadership, character, and sportsmanship. The second goes to a Haverford senior who displays excellence in community service. This award honors Coach Juenger's lifelong devotion to Janet, his daughter with special needs.
