Nationally recognized music programs competing at state and nationals levels.

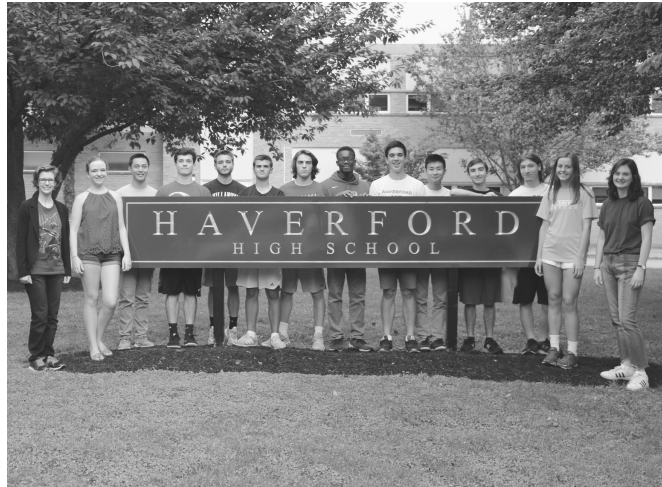
The School District of Haverford Township placed on the College Board's 9th Annual AP[®] District Honor Roll. We are one of the 373 school districts in the U.S. and Canada to reach this achievement.

The School District of Haverford Township received a \$35,000 PA Smart grant to expand computer science classes and teacher training.

Haverford Middle School Olympics has raised over \$150,000 supporting Bringing Hope Home for local families with cancer. They are the top fundraising school in the country.

Through the Potter Cup, Haverford Middle School has helped raise over \$500,000 for Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (ALSF).

Chatham Park Elementary Kindergarten thru 5th-grade students packaged 10,000 meals for 3 local food banks through The Outreach Program.



Chestnutwold Elementary School is a 2019 Pennsylvania State School of Character. The program recognizes Chestnutwold as a school that has demonstrated its use of character development to drive a positive impact on academics, student behavior, and the school climate.

Manoa Elementary participated in a school-wide reading incentive to raise money for the Ronald McDonald House of Philadelphia. Manoa raised over \$2,700 as a school.

Lynnewood Elementary School raised \$7,300 for the American Heart Association through a Jump-A-Thon and Heart Healthy Days. Lynnewood was a top fundraising school this year during the Kids Heart Challenge event!

Coopertown Elementary School offers a community service club for third and fourth-grade students called the Coopertown Cares Club. The goal is to lay the foundation for responsible citizenship as the children learn kindness, respect, and empathy. The students meet once a month to work on projects to help veterans, the homeless, the elderly, and much more.

Approximately 6,591 students attend the School District of Haverford Township's schools.
