

Harry Ernst Scholarship:

This scholarship was created by former students, friends, and family to honor the life and legacy of Harry Ernst, who taught Science at Haverford High School from 1964-1995.

Applicant requirements:

- Applicant must have a good academic record.
- Applicant must be accepted to a post-secondary program for Secondary Education or the Natural Sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Atmospheric Science, Oceanography, Environmental Science, Marine Biology, Physics, etc).
- Applicant must complete a response to the following essay question supplied by the Harry Ernst Scholarship Committee (no more than 500 words).

Scholarship Essay: Please describe someone who has inspired you. How has that person made a difference in your life?

- Include a title page with the following information:
Scholarship name, Applicant name, Home address, Phone number, Email address, Name of School/University applicant is planning to attend, Intended college major:
- Include first and last name on each page of the essay.

This scholarship will be awarded to a student whose character best personifies the qualities and interests of Harry Ernst.

The completed essay must be emailed or hand-delivered to Mrs. Cynthia Costanzo in the HHS Counseling Office by **9:30am on Wednesday, March 24, 2021**. ccostanzo@haverfordsd.net

Absolutely no essays will be accepted after this deadline. Only applicants who have completed the required essay and applied for the Harry Ernst Scholarship through the HHS Scholarships and Awards Application will be considered.
